Others may prefer a visit to the Fullers Brewery (next to Mawson Arms) between 2 pm and 4pm and see how this world famous beer is brewed and have an opportunity to sample it before picking up the visitors to Chiswick House by 4.30pm and returning by coach to Chalfont St Giles by 5.30 pm
